SB-INS-003 | v1.0 | 2026-09-11 | Study | Synthetic data

Proposed rules for recording, conditionally holding and releasing energy-linked claims.

Object

A research module connecting the improvement of an underlying asset with evidence, rights and reinvestment.

Institutional buyer

Banks, depositories, custodians and infrastructure operators.

Payment obligation

No standalone yield. Fees and any distribution of underlying cash flows would be defined in separate custody, servicing and asset contracts.

Units and term

Unique claim ID, underlying measurement interval and currency of the contractual payment.

Measurement and rights

Track the intervention, evidence and entitlement chain. Require independent approval before releasing a right. Record corrections, revocation, transfer and retirement without overwriting history.

Scenario record

Study scenarios: verified evidence allows conditional release; conflicting evidence places the claim on hold; failed measurement prevents release. A default or court restriction invokes a documented exception path. No licensed depository operation is represented.

Term and jurisdiction

Case-specific custody mandate, dispute procedure, termination and governing law.

Principal risks

Custody and title ambiguity; Oracle errors or compromised approvals; Software exceptions and key management; Insolvency, disputes and enforcement; History loss and duplicate claim creation.

Status and full record

Model dossier with unverified synthetic inputs. No issued instrument, measured pilot or contracted bank offtake is represented. Full same-version record: <https://spacebank.group/desk/SB-INS-003>
